Who? Mapping your neighbours and relational circles (Oikos) Ref: John 4 and John 17:20.

What? Part 1: Prayer walking and model Praying for people (1 practice) Attached *Prayer walking guide*

What? Part 2: My Story- Your testimony in 30 seconds (3 practices) Ref: John 4:29

What? Part 3: Three Circles gospel presentation (2 practices)

What? Part 4: Discovery Bible Study (DBS) e.g. Luke 5:27-32. Attached: *'DBS Curriculum Sets'*

DBS Questions

1. What are you thankful for?
2. What's a challenge right now?
3. Pray for each other
4. How did you go with your last "I will ..." statement?

New Story

5. Retell the story in your own words
6. What do you like about this story?
7. What does this tell us about God or Jesus?
8. What do we learn about people?
9. What do you think God is saying to you personally? How will you apply what you have learned this week?
10. Who can you share this story with this week? (Names where possible).
11. Pray for your plans and friends

Prayer Walking Guide

Be at ease:

Prayer walking is a low-profile affair. Friends or family stroll two-by-two through their neighbourhood praying quietly as they go.

Though they usually walk unnoticed, prayer walkers quickly become aware of the realities and needs of their neighbours.

Provide a map of the area and prayer points for the elderly and others unable to walk.

How to do it:

You can prayer walk alone but sometimes we find our prayers more focused when expressed with another person. So pray audibly for clarity and agreement.

Invite the Holy Spirit to accompany you to guide your steps and words.

Be attentive, allowing the Holy Spirit to help you see with His eyes and pray with accordance with His heart.

Pray for businesses you pass and schools and other organisations that they would prosper and act with integrity within the community.

Address God directly, asking Him to save people and to restrain the enemy. Pray against any strongholds or issues in the area- against illness, addictions, abuse, family breakdown, financial tensions, unemployment.

Pray blessing on the single people, families, parents, marriages, youth and children, the elderly.

Pray for God's breath on the homes, preparing them for our upcoming visit- softening their heart, making them aware of their sin and great need for Jesus.

Pray that they will be sensitized to want to know more about Jesus and kept from distractions.

Pray for more workers for the harvest.

Pray for an opportunity to start Discovery Bible Study groups in this community.

Bridging Statements/Questions

- *Do you have a spiritual belief? (Ask questions about their faith)*
- *Have you ever felt drawn to God?*
- *I have been a follower of Jesus for a long time but I have never had a chance to share with you how that happened.*
- *I was wondering about ... or I am curious about ...*
- *What are the joys and challenges in your life right now?*
- *What are you passionate about?*
- *Have you ever felt that God let you down?*
- *When have you felt near or far from God?*
- *If God was to do anything to meet a need in your life, what would that be?*
- *If God was to do a miracle in your life, or the life of someone you love, what would it be? Can I pray for that right now? God did a miracle in my life...*
- *Do you ever long for us to have a deeper conversation?*
- *I want you to know ... Do you know ...?*
- *Share a Bible story/Jesus story from memory - see what impact it had, "What gets your attention in that story?"*
- *Share Jesus' wisdom:
e.g. "Where your treasure is there will your heart be also"*
- *Your story: you don't need to ask permission to tell your story!*
- *Give a Bible / Gospel*
- *Ask God for bridging statements*
